Student Government Association Election Guidelines

1. Anyone seeking the position of SGA President or Senator-at-Large must meet with the current President of SGA. Those seeking any other position must meet with the individual currently holding that office. The purpose of this meeting will be to help those individuals running for a position, understand the responsibilities and the time commitments of the position sought.
An information session will be held in Hamlin Hall at 6:15 on Sunday April 10th for students interested in running for positions
2. Any full time Trinity College undergraduate is eligible for election to hold executive office provided that he or she has served in the SGA for at least a semester and is not on academic probation.
3. In order to be placed on the election ballot, the person seeking the office must obtain the required number of signatures.

Class Senator	Require 25 Signatures from Classmates
Senator-at Large / Budget Committee	Require 50 Signatures from Student Body
Officer Positions	Require 75 Signatures from Classmates/Student Body
Secretary Positions	Require 50 Signatures from Student Body
EAC Representative	Require 50 Signatures from Student Body
4. Neither candidates nor their campaign workers may in any way impede the campaign activities of another candidate.
5. All postings must be stamped at Mather Front Desk.
6. Candidates understand that the election results are the property of the SGA and may be published.
7. Voters may cast their vote only once.
8. Mass e-mails sent by, or on behalf of, any candidates are not allowed.
